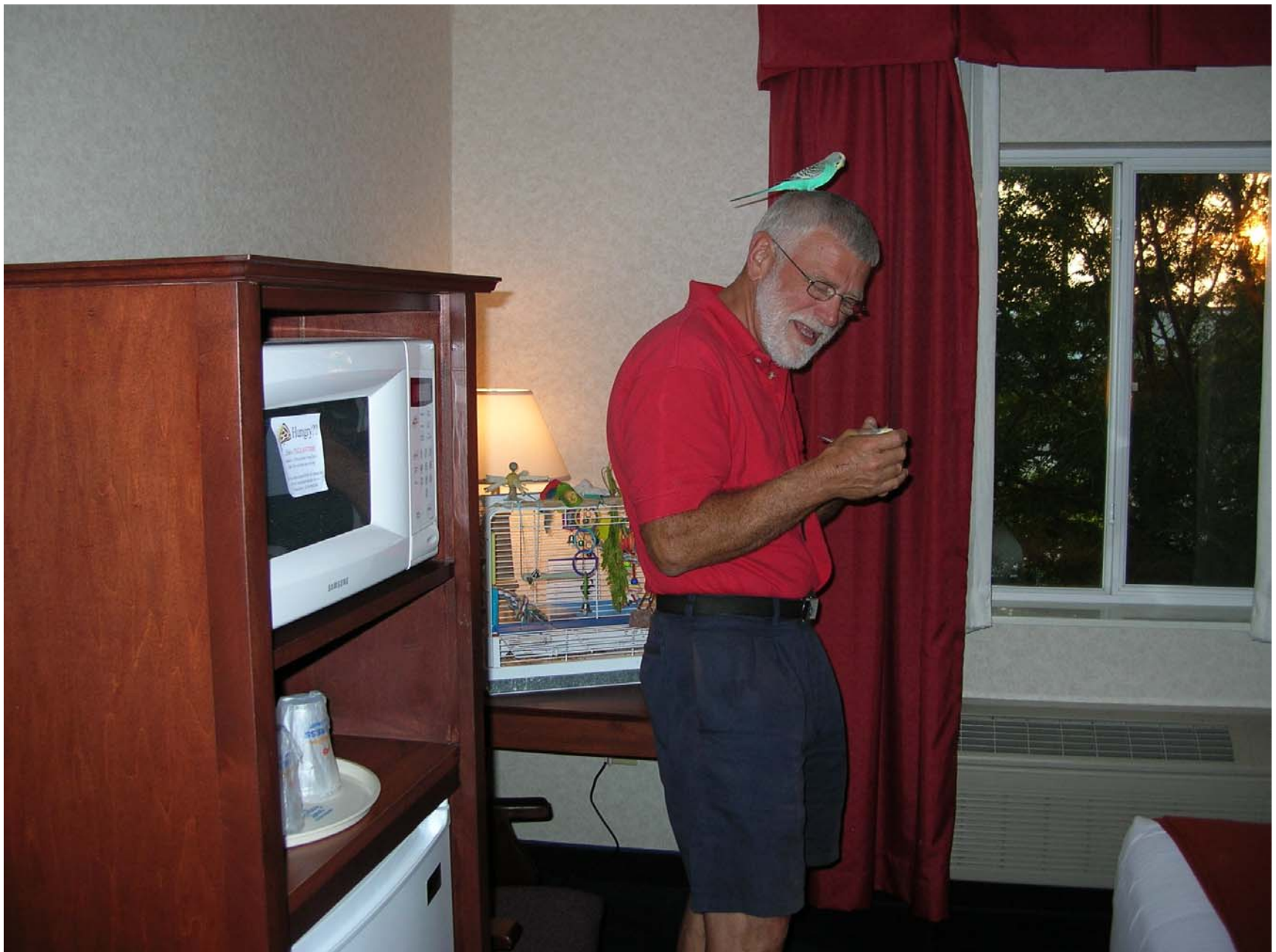

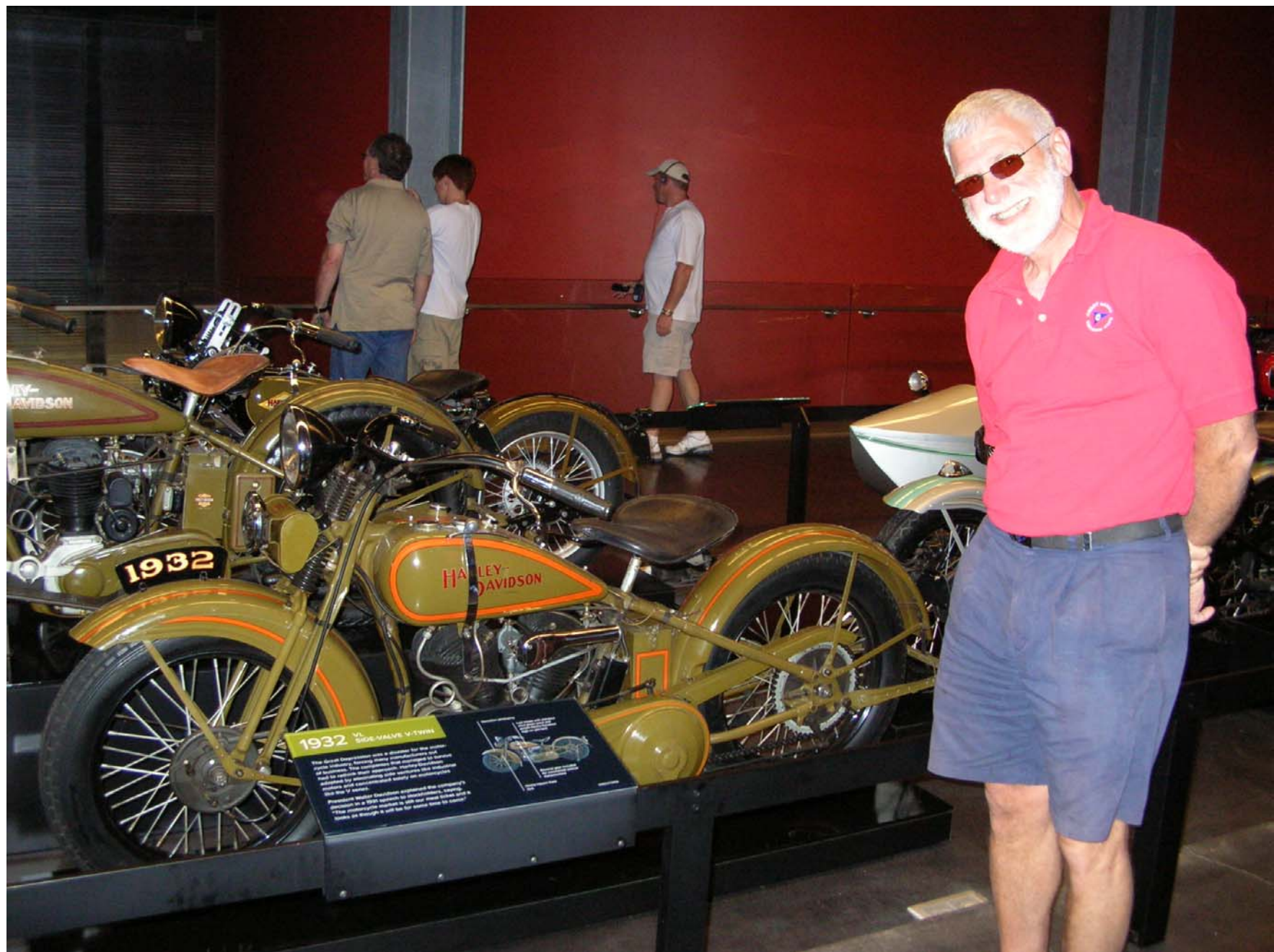

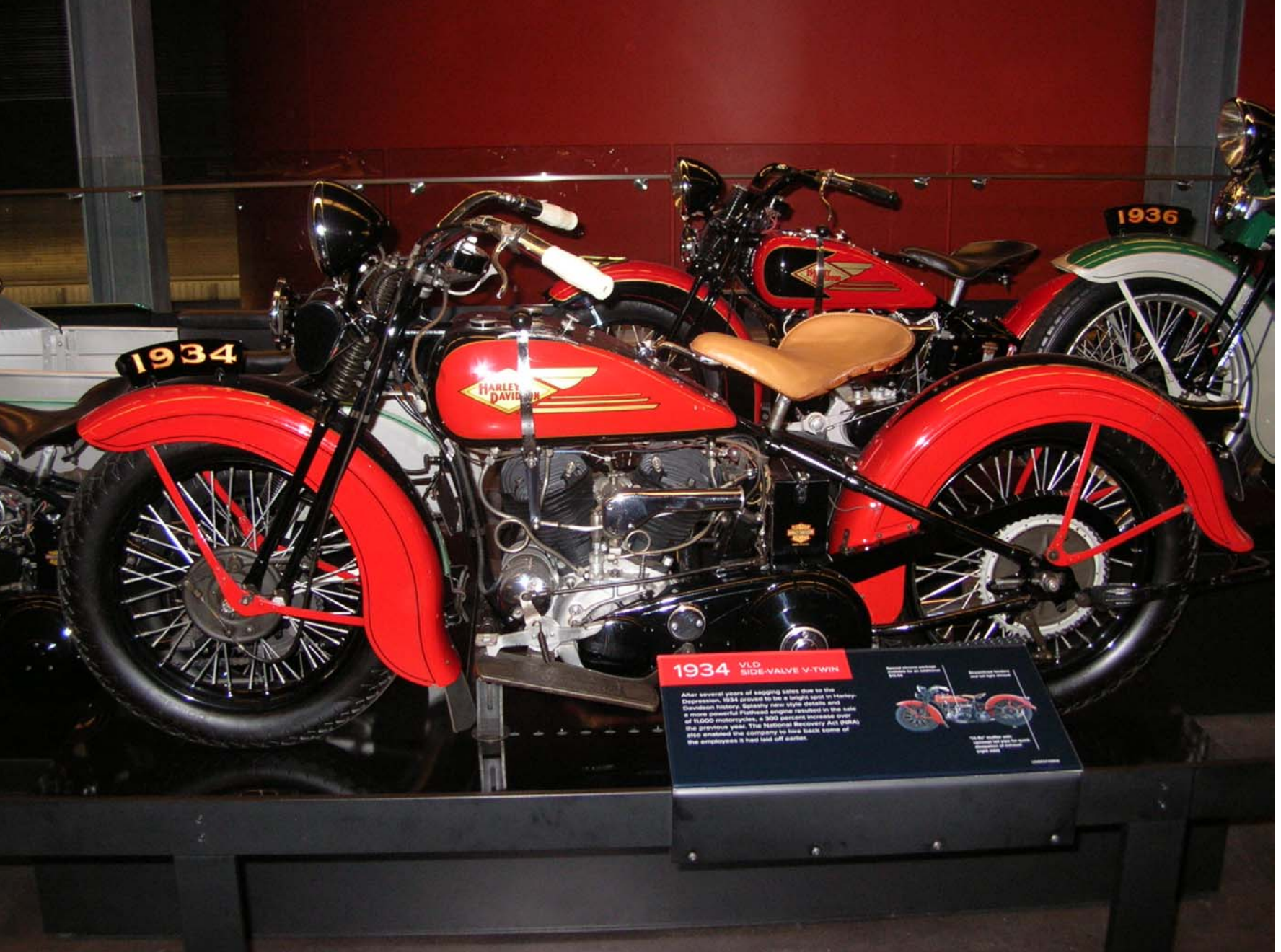

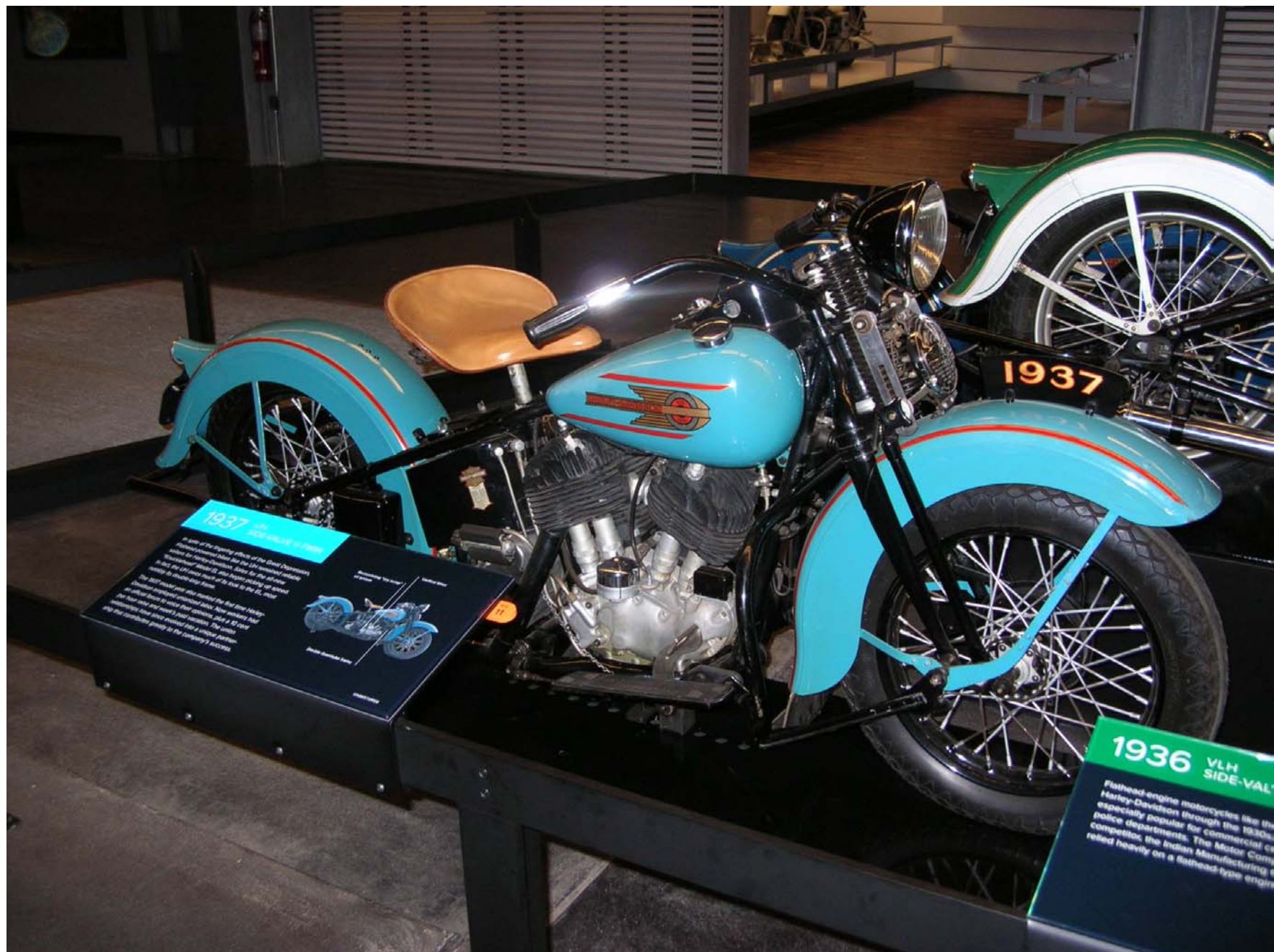

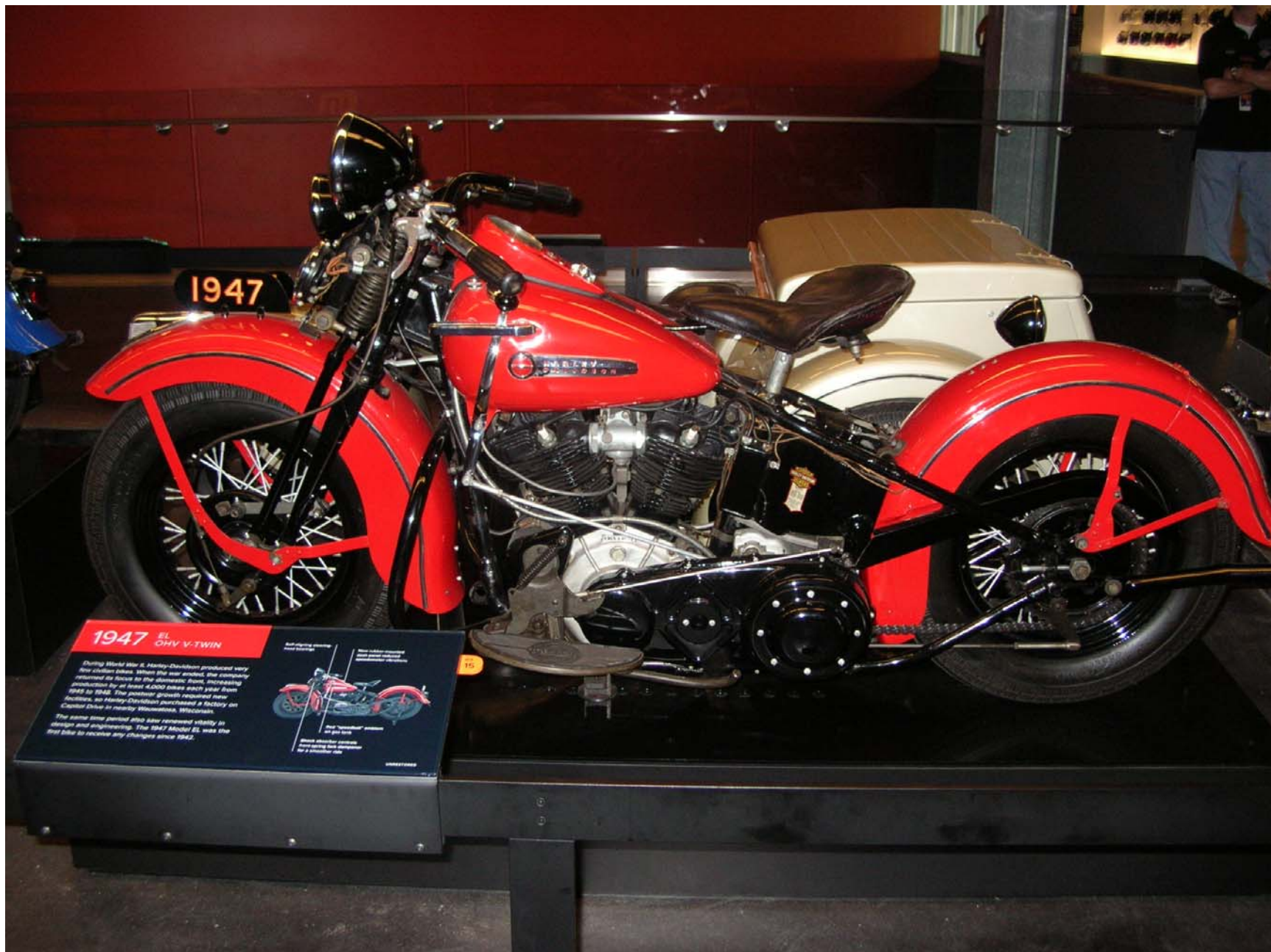
Carl had the same Harley model as this one in his youth.





Carl had a 1937 Harley model like this one too.





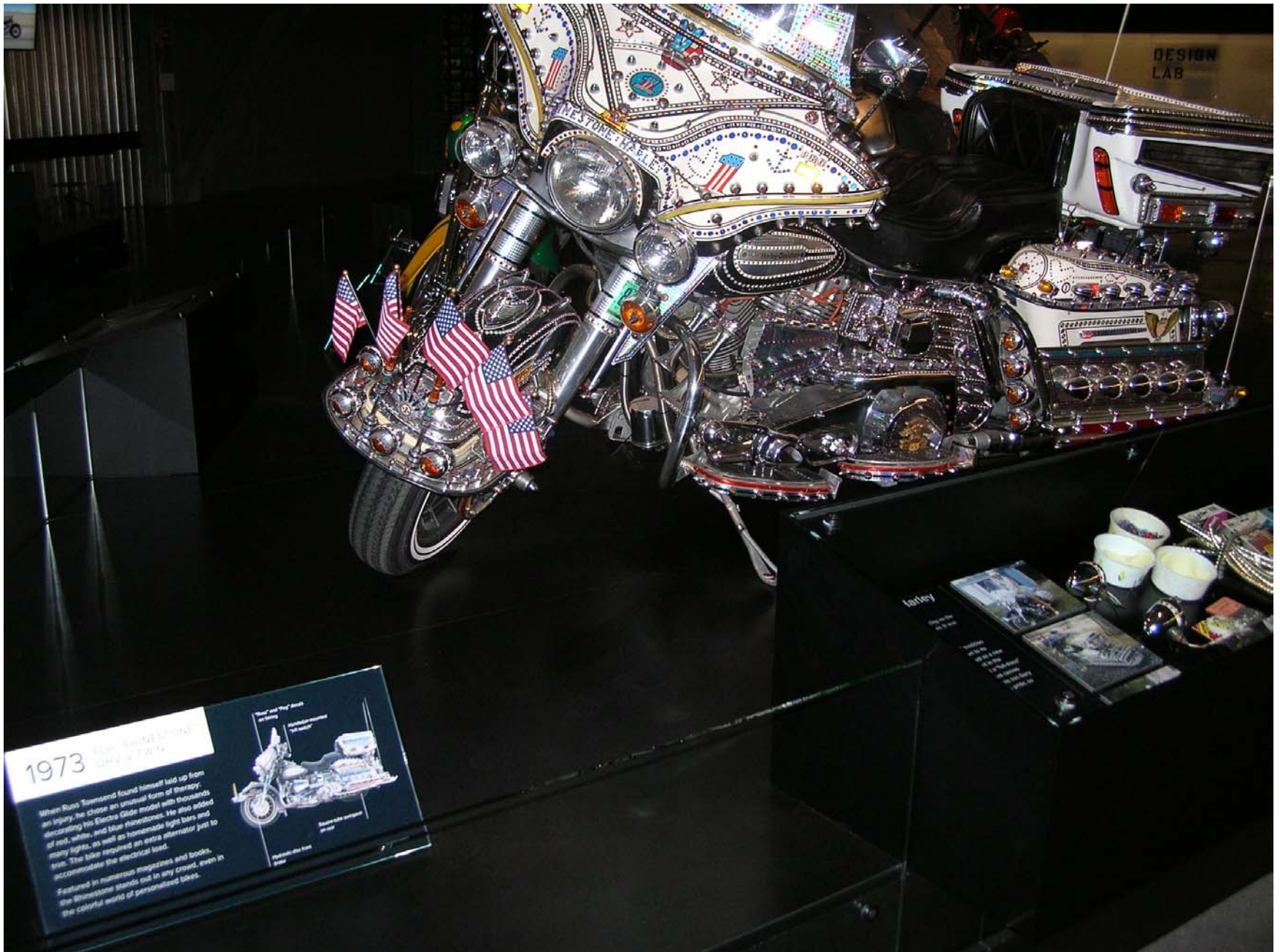
